

HAMBURG PULLING RULES(Blacktop)

GENERAL RULES

1. Tractor serial numbers must be in the correct place.
2. Anyone caught tampering with a tractor other than their own will automatically be disqualified.
3. Engine speed must be controlled by a throttle lever. **NO STRINGS OR WIRES ALLOWED.**
4. Anyone using profanity towards track officials will be disqualified, and forfeit next pull.
5. Maximum drawbar height is **20 inches** at the point of hook for all classes. Minimum of 18 inches from center of rear axle to the point of hook. Must have a ridged drawbar. Fast hitches **MUST** be locked. Puller must supply a 3 ½ inch pulling eye, or a twist clevis.
6. Where weights or parts fall off is the measurement of pull.
7. Each tractor is limited to two hooks per tractor unless otherwise instructed by track officials.
8. Anyone refusing to weigh a tractor before or after pulling will be disqualified.
9. Drivers must be 14 years of age or older. **All drivers enter at your own risk.** Drivers between the ages of 14 and 18 must have parent's written consent, and safety class certificate with them.
NO EXCEPTIONS!!
10. No re-pull for first driver in each class. Registration position is pull position.
11. Drivers are allowed to readjust weight in the first 50 feet, if they can restart under their own power.
12. In the paced classes drivers will have 75 feet to control speed, or will be disqualified.
13. No locked or welded rear ends.
14. Tractors will be inspected and weighed in to meet the above rules.
15. There will be a drivers meeting before the pulls.
16. Due to the amount of children and people walking around, **ABSOLUTELY NO HOTRODING AROUND PITS OR SCALE WILL BE TOLERATED. IF CAUGHT MONEY AND PULL WILL BE FORFEITED AND YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.**
17. When the flag drops at the end of your pull step in the clutch no smoking the tires.
18. **TRACK OFFICIAL'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL!!!**

STOCK(Antique) 1959 and older

MUST HAVE!!!

Stock block; Stock Head; Stock Ignition; Stock Size Wheels, 12inches wide max. **10% over stock RPM.**

Original chassis & engine parts. **Factory wheel and frame weights. Must pull in First or Second Gear. Weight is to be right on unless authorized by track official. Stock(Antique) will be allowed to pull SEMI-STOCK Class, but will retain STOCK(Antique) Rules.**

NO... Stripping of any kind to make weight; Homemade weight brackets. No cut tires-**BIAS PLY ONLY.**

No pressed steel wheels unless factory equipped. No covers on the PTO or Belt pulley covers. No Funks Conversions.

No turn buckles for drawbar adjustment. **Use of T/A or Power director is NOT allowed.**

SEMI-STOCK 1959 and older

MUST HAVE!!!

If no pace then First or Second Gear. Must retain original engine and chassis parts; Working Governor. **No strings, wire or foot feeds allowed. 10% over stock RPM.**

Points and condenser may be removed and replaced with Exciter Ignition. Must have positive throttle stop; Stock Intake flange size for the newest model in the class. Top shaved tires are allowed. No cutting front of the lug. Farthest forward point cannot exceed 11 feet from the center of the rear axle. **Use of T/A or Power Director is NOT allowed.**

NO... M's, 88's, 44's & like tractors below 4500lbs

Wheelie bars, kill switches, fenders, recommended, but not required. **SEMI-STOCK TRACTORS NOT ALLOWED TO PULL IN THE STOCK(Antique) CLASS.**

Weight is to be right on, no allowances. Classes are as follows: 3500,4000,4500,5000,5500,6000,6500.

Classes are subject to change on the day of pull!

FARM CLASS Any year is allowed

MUST HAVE!!!

Must be a "Farm" Tractor. For Example, original frame, rear end, trans, PTO, etc. Must be installed and working. Stock Injection Pump, Stock Turbo, **NO water injection**. Stock engine RPM only! 20.8 max width tires, not cut or sharpened. (True road worn is ok.) No 4WD or front wheel assist will be allowed. Weights must be in factory location on the wheels or front weight brackets. 3pt weight brackets are prohibited. **T/A and Power Directors are allowed. Must run the factory designated fuel, Gas, Diesel, or LP. Farm tractors will be paced at 7MPH.**

Classes are as follows: 7500,8500,9500,10500,12000,14000

HOT FARM Any year is allowed

Turbo and non-turbo tractors will run together. No coolers, NOS, or Propane allowed! Single turbo only.

ALL TRACTORS MUST HAVE SAFETY EQUIPMENT- Wheelie bars, air shut-off, fire extinguisher, scatter blankets, or steel flywheel, cross bolts in exhaust is strongly recommended. 2 3/8 bolts 90*x 1" apart no more than 10" from the turbo outlet. Tractors are allowed to have cut tires, MSD ignition, one carb, stock interchange of engine parts, homemade intake and header, **NO homemade heads**. Fenders are strongly suggested. No tire size limit. **T/A or Power Directors are allowed.**

Weight must be right on no allowances.

**Classes are as follows:5500,6500,7500. 7MPH Pace.
9500,10500,11500,12500. 10MPH Pace**

Classes are subject to change on the day of pull!
